### Academy of Business & Information Technology \*

This academy offers specialized pathways in:

**Business Management ‡** – provides opportunities for students to manage and supervise activities related to the organization of a business. Students develop and implement a business plan, and learn to provide effective and efficient management of business operations.

**Marketing ‡** – provides opportunities for students to strategize business activities related to selling, customer support services, and public relations. Students analyze customer markets, determine product mix, pricing, promotion, distribution, and learn public relations strategies.

#### Information Technology – Programming ‡

– allows students to design, develop, and test software solutions and develop expertise in project management and programming languages, as well as introductory computer science.

‡ Students may earn a minimum of four MSDE Career & Technical Education (CTE) credits for graduation.
