### Academy of Leadership & Humanities

This academy offers specialized pathways in:

**Homeland Security-Criminal Justice\*\*** – this Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness (HSEP) program integrates government, academia, and private sector training/educational initiatives to help students understand how the United States and its interests worldwide are protected against threats to public safety, both natural and manmade, through effective communication, preparedness, detection, prevention, response and recovery.

**Marine JROTC** – provides students with information and valuable life-long learning skills. The military science program focuses on living the leadership traits and core values of honor, courage, and commitment. Students practice self-discipline, teamwork, and citizenship through leadership experiences, career exploration, and general military subjects.
