

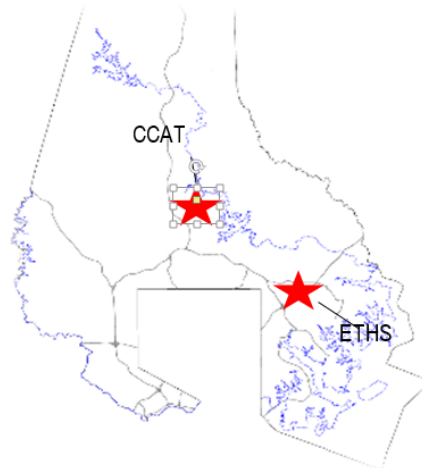
## BCPS Magnet Programs High School Programs

### Interactive Media Production \*‡

This program provides students with experiences in Web site development, internet technology, computer graphics, digital media and entertainment production, and project management. Students develop skills in photo/video imagery, animation, non-linear video editing, Web page design, basic game development, and mobile/ handheld application development. Students complete a professional portfolio which can be used to apply for advanced/continuing education programs and employment. Students may also earn industry certification in Adobe® Creative Suite® and Web design.
