International Baccalaureate (IB)

This program provides an internationally recognized, rigorous academic program that prepares students for college. Students in Grades 9 and 10 participate in school-wide IB instruction through Kenwood's IB Middle Years Program candidacy and take advanced academic courses to prepare them for the IB Diploma Program. The Diploma Program is for students in Grades 11 and 12 and includes study topics such as Literature, Language, Individuals & Societies, Mathematics, Experimental Sciences, and the Arts. Students are offered choices within those areas in order to cover topics both in depth and breadth, as well as accommodating individual student interests. Students completing the requirements for the Diploma Program may receive college credit for IB course work.
