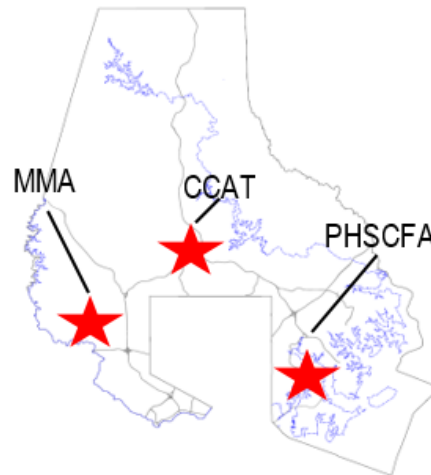


BCPS Magnet Programs High School Programs
