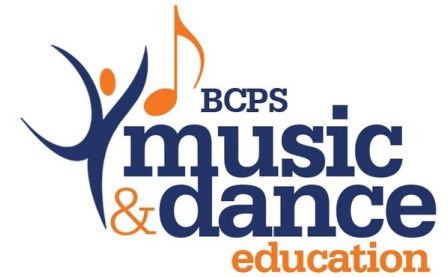

**BCPS Virtual Songwriting Camp - July 6-9, 2021 - 12:30-3:30PM**

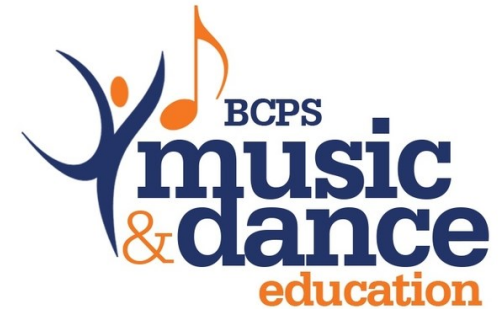

## **BCPS Virtual Ukulele Camp - July 6-9, 2021 - 9am-12pm**

**Program Cost: \$100**

This musical opportunity provides allows students to create, respond, perform, and connect to music with emphasis on using a soprano ukulele. Students will develop musicianship skills that include fingerpicking melodies, playing chords to accompany songs, interpreting song lyrics and musical form, and connecting to the history and cultural uses of the ukulele.

Calling at singer/songwriters! This virtual camp opportunity is geared to students looking to explore aspects of songwriting and musical composition. During the camp, participants will explore aspects of lyric creation, songwriting, music production, and musicianship skills needed to produce musical works original to their own style. Students will work to create an original musical composition that will be showcased as if it were to be a #1 hit on the charts.
