

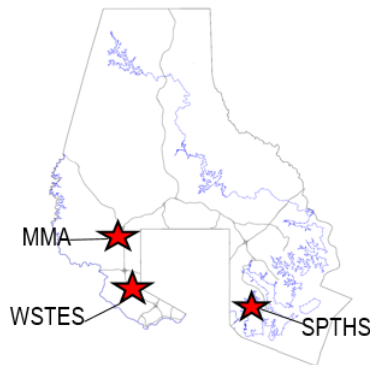
BCPS Magnet Programs High School Programs

Automotive Service Technology **

This program introduces students to automotive service and repair. Students perform selected skilled services outlined in Automotive Service Excellence (ASE) requirements using specialized tools and equipment on late-model vehicles. Students learn ASE certified skills through computerized content instruction, shop demonstrations, diagnostic testing, and hands-on activities performed on shop vehicles. Students who complete the program successfully may earn certification in Suspension and Steering, Brakes, Electrical/Electronic Systems, Engine Performance, Engine Repair, Heating and Air Condition, Automatic Transmission and Transaxle, and Manual Drive Train. Students will be expected to sit for ASE certification exam at each level of the program.

* *Articulated college credit may be earned from the Community College of Baltimore County.*
