This program provides all students with an opportunity to participate in health and wellness-related lessons and activities, including units of student study on *Health Bodies*, *Health Minds*, and *Healthy Relationships*; bi-annual community health fairs; field trips to local science/healthcare settings; optional First Aid, CPR, and Stop the Bleed training; and diverse academic experiences which include a number of Career and Technical Education pathways, such as the Academy of Health Professions, Nutrition and Foods Science, Business, Homeland Security, as well as AVID college preparation courses, all with a schoolwide emphasis on student wellness.
